CHAPTER 330-X-16 DISCIPLINARY ACTION

330-X-16-.02 <u>Probable Cause</u>. Upon receiving a complaint the Executive Director shall refer the complaint to one member of the Board; provided, however, that if the complaint is first made to a Board member, then it shall be referred to that Board member. The Board member to whom a complaint is referred, the Executive Director, <u>and</u> the Board's attorney, and the Board investigator (Investigative Committee), by a unanimous vote of the committee, shall determine appropriate action and/or whether probable cause exists. If charges are filed, the Board member who was a member of the Investigative Committee that made the probable cause determination shall not sit as a member of the Board at the disciplinary hearing held pursuant to the charges.
