CHAPTER 330-X-9 CLASSIFICATIONS OF LICENSURE

330-X-9-.01 Classification of Licensure.

- (1) Applicants shall be licensed under one or more of the following titles:
- (a) Professional Engineer
- (b) Professional Land Surveyor.
- (2) Applicants shall be certified under one or more of the following titles:
- (a) Engineer Intern
- (b) Land Surveyor Intern.
- (3) Chapter 11, Title 34, <u>Code of Ala. 1975</u> makes no specific designations as to the discipline of engineering or land surveying practice for which a license as Professional Engineer or Professional Land Surveyor shall be issued; however, the Rules of Professional Conduct, Rule 330-X-14-.03, provides that a professional engineer or professional land surveyor shall practice only in technical fields in which he or she is qualified by education or experience. Discipline of examinations taken by a licensee is considered a public record.
