## 255-X-10-.02 Applicants Qualified Endorsement of Out-of-State License.

Applicants who hold a currently licensed in good standing or certified to practice counseling issued by a similar board counseling licensure authority in another state, territorial possession of the United States, District of Columbia, or Commonwealth of Puerto Rico must meet the following requirements may apply for endorsement of that license by:

- (1) Applicant must submit an application on a form approved by the Board.
- (2). Applicants must supply a copy of the educational and supervised experience requirements in effect on the date of their application to the state of current licensure.
- (2)(3) The Board may, at its discretion, waive the formal examination requirements of an applicant, provided that the applicant has a passing score on a written counseling examination that, in the opinion of the Board, is substantially equivalent to the examination established by the Alabama Board.
- (3)(4) Applications will be reviewed and Applicants must meet the Alabama educational and supervised experience requirements of the Alabama regulations that were in effect on the date of the first issuance in the state of the current license of their application to the state of current licensure.
  - (4) (5) Issuance of License.
- (a) The Board shall issue a license to applicants who satisfactorily meet all requirements in (1) through (3)(4) above.
