## 255-X-3-.05 Supervising Associate. Repealed.

- (1) General. Supervising Associates shall be Licensed Professional Counselors and shall render clinical supervision, under the supervision of a Supervising Counselor, for Associate Licensed Counselors.
- (2) Effective January 1, 1998, Supervising Associates must comply with the following requirements:
  - (a) Document a minimum of two (2) years of full time (20+ hours per week) clinical practice as a licensed professional counselor (LPC).
  - (b) Submit a written recommendation from the Supervising Counselor in 255-X-3-.04(2)b.
  - (c) Read and agree to uphold the Association for Counselor Education and Supervision (ACES) Ethical Code of Supervision in their supervision of the ALC.
  - (d) Agree to supervision by the Supervising Counselor in 255-X-3-.04(2)b. consisting of a minimum of four (4) hours per month to include at least two (2) hours of one-to-one, face-to-face, personal individual supervision.
- (3) The total number of ALCs supervised by the Supervising Associate shall not exceed three (3).
