395-X-1-.01 Organization. The Alabama Board of Funeral Service is made up of seven members, one from each U.S. Congressional District of the state. The term of a member shall be two years and no person may serve more than two terms four consecutive terms. Four (4) of the members shall have been practicing and licensed embalmers in Alabama for the ten (10) consecutive years immediately preceding their appointment and shall be licensed as embalmers and funeral directors during their terms. Three (3) of the members shall have been actively engaged in funeral directing in Alabama for ten (10) consecutive years, immediately preceding their appointment, and shall be licensed as funeral directors and shall be operators of a funeral establishment in this state at the time of their appointment. Should a member, for any reason, become ineligible to serve on the Board, the position shall become vacant and a new person, properly qualified, shall be appointed by the Governor to fill the vacancy and said person shall complete the remainder of such term. The Board officers consist of chairman chair, vice chairman chair, treasurer, and secretary. These positions shall be filled by the Board during the first meeting immediately following the appointment each year. No more than four (4) members of the Board shall be of the same race, nor hall shall the chairman chair or vice chairman chair be of the same race.

395-X-1-.02 Nomination and Appointment.

In October of each year, a meeting shall be held in Montgomery for the purpose of nominating eligible candidates to serve on the Board. Nominations are taken for Districts One (1), Two (2), and Five(5) on even numbered years and Districts Three (3), Four (4), Six(6), and Seven (7) on odd numbered years. Three nominees from each district shall be selected and their names submitted to the Governor, who shall appoint one person from each district. No more than two nominees from each district can be of the same race. New members are sworn in at the first regular meeting following December 31 of the respective year.
