## CHAPTER 395-X-7 EYE ENUCLEATING TECHNICIANS TABLE OF CONTENTS

395-X-7-.01 Application 395-X-7-.02 Certification Training Course 395-X-7-.03 Licensure And Renewal

**395-X-7-.01 Application.** Anyone wishing to become a licensed eye enucleating technician shall make written application to the Board on a form provided by the Board or the Alabama Lion's Eye and Tissue Bank. In order to qualify for a license as an enucleating technician, the applicant shall: (a) be a licensed embalmer in the state of Alabama; (b) have completed a course of study in mortuary science at such school or college as defined in the state funeral service laws; and (c) have completed a certification training course of the Alabama Lion's Eye and Tissue Bank in eye enucleation instruction.

**395-X-7-.02 Certification Training Course.** Anyone meeting all other requirements for licensure and wishing to enroll in the enucleation certification training course may do so by informing the Board office or the Alabama Lion's Eye and Tissue Bank prior to the date of the course, which shall be set by the eye bank. It is the Board's intent that an apprentice embalmer may enroll in the training course, provided the said apprentice will become eligible for an embalmer license within six months of the training course.

**395-X-7-.03 Licensure And Renewal.** Each licensed enucleating technician shall be eligible for renewal of said license each October 1st by performing at least one eye enucleation or completing a refresher training course not more than two years prior to said renewal date. The Alabama Lion's Eye and Tissue Bank shall keep an accurate record of all enucleations and of those persons completing refresher training courses and submit to the Board, no later than September 1 of each year, a list of all licensed technicians eligible for renewal. Should a licensee fail to meet the renewal requirements of this section, the license may only be renewed by completing a refresher training course.
