Any recipient who fails for any reason to continue his/her optometric education or to begin practicing optometry within one (1) year following completion of optometry school shall repay all loan amounts in accordance with terms and conditions established by the Board, provided that the interest rate on such unpaid loan amounts shall be fixed at a rate determined by the Board six percent (6%) per annum from the date of his/her departure from optometry school.
