165-X-14-.15 Non-Sanctioned Events.

- (1) Any Amateur Mixed Martial Arts Sanctioning Organization licensed by the state or the Amateur Mixed Martial Arts Sanctioning Organization's personnel shall not participate in events not sanctioned by a tribal or state commission. Any Amateur Mixed Martial Arts Sanctioning Organization who participates or has personnel participating in a show not sanctioned by an approved state or tribal commission shall be subject to disciplinary action.
- (2) Any amateur mixed martial artist, professional mixed martial artist, or professional boxer participating in a boxing or mixed martial arts event not sanctioned by an approved tribal or state commission shall be suspended for a minimum of 60 days pending a hearing.
- (3) For the purposes of this rule, an approved tribal or state commission is one recognized by the Association of Boxing Commissions.
