## 335-5-1-.05 Registry of Environmental Covenants.

- (1) The Department shall establish and maintain a registry that contains all environmental covenants and any amendment or termination of those covenants executed pursuant to 335-5.
- (2) In addition to the requirements of 335-5-1-.05(1), the registry may contain any other information concerning environmental covenants and the real property subject to them which the Department considers appropriate.
- (3) The full text of the covenant, amendment, or termination and any other information required by ADEM shall be submitted to ADEM within thirty (30) days of its execution recording in the land records of the county where the property is located for inclusion in the ADEM Registry of Environmental Covenants. The person submitting the covenant may be the owner, operator, other responsible person, grantor or any holder of the covenant.
