SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The intent of the proposed amendment to this regulation is to adopt section 2-3.1.5 of the 1998 Edition of NFPA 58 that was deleted by the Alabama LP-Gas Board when the remainder of the document was adopted January 14, 1999. The section in question requires overfill prevention device valves (OPD) on specified cylinders used to transport LP-gas.
