- 355-9-1-.11 <u>Minimum Qualifications and Requirements for a Public Defender</u>. Should a Board determine that the method for delivering indigent defense services in its county or circuit is by the establishment of a Public Defender's office and the selection and appointment of a Public Defender, it shall do so in accordance with the Act. The minimum qualifications and requirements for the position of Public Defender shall be:
- (a) The individual sought to be appointed must be a member in good standing with the Alabama State Bar and any other bar association of which the individual is a member;
- (b) The individual sought to be appointed must have a minimum of eight (8) years of criminal practice experience, preferably with criminal trial experience;
- (c) The individual sought to be appointed must have the ability to effectively administer the Public Defender's office;
- (d) The individual sought to be appointed may not be related to a judge in the same county or judicial circuit within the 4<sup>th</sup> degree of consanguinity (first cousin), inclusive;
- (e) The individual sought to be appointed must be a resident of the county in which he or she will serve as Public Defender before taking office.
