EXPLOSIVES SAFETY ACT VARIATION FEE

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482-2-104-.01 Purpose, Scope and Authority.

(1) The purpose of this chapter is to formalize the practice within the State Fire Marshal's Office preceding the effective date of this chapter and set the fee for requesting the State Fire Marshal approve an emergency variation from the requirements of the Alabama Explosives Safety Act of 1993, Ala. Code §§ 8-17-240, et seq. (1993).

(2) This chapter shall apply to all persons submitting a written request for an emergency variation in accordance with Ala. Code \$ 8-17-250 (1993).

(3) This chapter is adopted pursuant to Ala. Code \$\$ 27-2-17 (1975) and 8-17-250 (1993).
