SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The State Fire Marshal is proposing to adopt a new regulation to set the fees necessary for the administration and enforcement of Article 10 of Chapter 17 of Title 8, Code of Alabama 1975, known as the Reduced Cigarette Ignition Propensity Standards and Firefighter Protection Act. The fees were initially set in 2009 in Section 8-17-273, Code of Alabama 1975. The revisions adjust the fees according to changes in the Consumer Price Index over the last six years as permitted by Alabama Act No. 2015-441. The proposed effective date of the new regulation is January 1, 2016.
