CHAPTER 165-X-20 LICENSING FOR AMATEUR MMA SANCTIONING ORGANIZATIONS

165-X-20-.01 Licensure Application.

- (1) Application for licensing. An amateur mixed martial arts sanctioning organization shall submit an application in writing to the Alabama Athletic Commission no less than thirty (30) days in advance of the organizations first match, contest, or exhibition in the state.
- (2) Applications. Each application for sanctioning organization license shall be accompanied with a cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$1,000.00 and made out to the Alabama Athletic Commission.
- (3) Security Bond. Each application for sanctioning organization license shall be accompanied with an appropriate security bond to be determined by the commission.
- (4) Application Signatures. Applications for sanctioning organization license shall be signed in the presence of a Commission representative, or shall be signed in the presence of and verified by a notary public. Annual license. Licenses shall be issued annually beginning January 1 and terminating December 31 of the current calendar year.
- (5) Video of individual fights. The licensed sanctioning organization shall provide the Commission's executive director a video of all matches, contests, or exhibitions within ten (10) days of any match, contest, or exhibition they host. The video shall be provided in a format acceptable to the Commission or the commission executive director.

The Commission reserves the right to change the requested format of the video at any time. All videos will be accompanied by the official results of the matches, contests, or exhibitions.

165-X-20-.02 Certification Of Results.

- Certification of results. The Alabama Athletic (1)Commission is the only organization permitted by state regulations to certify the results of individual amateur mixed martial arts contests.
- The commission shall review and certify all individual fight results before they are submitted by the Commission's executive director to the national registry.
- A licensed organization must submit a signed affidavit stating that all amateur contests for each individual event were held according to Athletic commission rules; were strictly followed and enforced.
- Any contest not certified by the Alabama Athletic Commission shall be listed as a non-sanctioned fight in the fighter's official record.
- Non-sanctioned fights will not be applied to the fighter's win/loss record in the national registry.

165-X-20-.03 Joint Ventures.

Joint ventures. Any licensed sanctioning organization who partners or joint-ventures with any other licensed sanctioning organization for the promotion of an amateur mixed martial arts match, contest, or exhibition in this state, shall disclose to the Commission their intent to do so.

- (a) Denial of joint ventures. The Alabama Athletic Commission reserves the right to deny joint ventures of any kind.
- (b) Spot compliance checks. All sanctioning organizations of amateur mixed martial arts licensed by the Alabama Athletic Commission shall be subject to spot compliance checks by an authorized Commission representative at any of their matches, contests, or exhibitions to ensure that all Alabama Athletic Commission amateur MMA rules are strictly followed and enforced.
- (c) Compliance. Lack of compliance with any statue governing amateur mixed martial arts or these rules results may result in disciplinary action.
