750-X-1-.01 Membership. There are seven members of the Board who are residents of this state, who shall be appointed by the Governor under conditions set forth in section 34-26-21(a). At least two one members shall be chosen from, and shall be a members of the faculty, with the rank of assistant professor or above, of the accredited colleges and universities of the state, who shall be $\underline{\mathbf{a}}$ licensed psychologists under the provisions of this chapter, and shall be primarily engaged in teaching, research, or administration of psychology. Three Five members shall be licensed practicing psychologists under this chapter. One member shall be licensed as a psychological technician. The person initially appointed to fill the psychological technician position on the board shall have a master's degree in psychology and shall not be required to be a licensed psychological technician. Any subsequent appointment to the psychological technician position on the board shall be a licensed psychological technician. Further, "two one members must be a members of the general public and an Alabama residents who are is not licensed by the Board and whose spouses, if married, are is not licensed by the Board., and one of the two public members, and his or her successors, must be black." Immediately upon the expiration or vacancy of the public position not held by a Black individual that public position on the board shall be abolished. Thereafter, only one public position shall remain on the board. That public position shall continue to be filled by a member of the general public who is Black. Efforts shall be made to have nominations, with due consideration, reflect the geographic, gender, racial, and ethnic diversity of the state without regard to political affiliation.
