488-X-1-.08 Non-Renewable Permit

(1) A non-renewable permit will expire twelve (12) months after the issuance date. The non-renewable permit limits the permit holder to providing services in the specific area for which the non-renewable permit has been issued. This permit cannot be renewed. A non-renewable permit may be obtained my submitting the following:

- (a) Notarized application for the non-renewable permit,
- (b) The payment of the nonrefundable fee,
- (c) One of the following:
 - (i) GED, High school Diploma or Certified transcripts
 - (ii) College diploma or college certified transcripts
- (d) The Board approved recommendation forms from three (3) licensed/certified Interpreters attesting to the skill level of the applicant,
- (e) Proof of citizenship and
- (f) Proof of citizenship form
