750-X-1-.01 Membership.

There is created the Alabama Board of Examiners in Psychology to consist of are seven members of the Board eight persons who are residents of this state, who shall be appointed by the Governor under conditions set forth in section 34-26-21(a) as follows:

- <u>a.</u> At least one <u>One</u> member shall be chosen from, and shall be a member of the faculty, with the rank of assistant professor or above, of the <u>an</u> accredited colleges and universities of <u>college</u> or <u>university</u> in the state, who shall be a licensed psychologist under the provisions of this chapter, and shall be <u>with the rank of assistant professor or above who is primarily engaged in teaching, research, or administration of psychology <u>and is a psychologist licensed under this chapter</u>.</u>
- <u>b.</u> Five members shall be licensed psychologists <u>licensed</u> under this chapter.
- <u>c.</u> One member shall be licensed as a psychological technician <u>licensed</u> under this chapter.
- <u>d.</u> Further, one <u>One</u> member <u>must shall</u> be a member of the general public and an Alabama resident who is not licensed by the Board and whose spouse, if married, is not licensed by the Board.
- (e) Efforts shall be made to have nominations, with due consideration, reflect the geographic, gender, racial, and ethnic diversity of the state without regard to political affiliation.
