

SUBJECT: <u>AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL</u> ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment to Attachment 4.19-B page 2 and 2b.

This amendment will allow the Agency's payments to be sufficient to enlist enough providers so that services under the plan are available to beneficiaries at least to the extent that those services are available to the general population.

Payments to teaching physicians must be reconciled annually through the average commercial rate demonstration. In order to maintain adequate access to specialty teaching physicians; all specialties include general practice, family practice, and general pediatrics.

SUBJECT: <u>AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL</u> ASSISTANCE

Effective January 1, 2015, the Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend Attachment 4.19 B of the Alabama State Plan for Medical Assistance. The plan is being amended in order to allow eligible primary care physicians with a specialty of family medicine, general internal medicine or pediatric medicine to receive enhanced payments for certain primary care services and Vaccines for Children (VFC) vaccine administration codes. Presently, the time period approved for the enhanced payment is January 1, 2015 through September 30, 2015.
