Any optometrist who fails to submit to, or cooperate with, an evaluation, or who fails to comply with treatment, rehabilitation or aftercare requirements, or fails to otherwise complete any designated treatment, rehabilitation or aftercare program, shall be subject to such limitation, restriction, suspension or revocation of his or her license as the Board may determine appropriate after the conduct of a due process hearing.
