<u>INTENDED ACTION:</u> Amendment of Certification Standards for Fire Service Personnel

### SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

To rescind the requirements that, in order to receive training, the candidate must first obtain employment or membership in a fire department.

To require that in order to be eligible for training and certification, the candidate meet the requirements of NFPA 1001, Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications.

To increase the number of required hours of training for career firefighter training to 360 hours, exclusive of training in emergency medical services.

To require that examinations administered during initial training are developed and approved by the Commission. Currently tests are developed by individual instructors.
