
PUBLIC NOTICE

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. This amendment will delegate authority to conduct administrative fair hearings to the Office of Attorney General. All other aspects of fair hearings will remain the same, i.e. recipients will be informed, in writing, of the fair hearing process and how to obtain information about fair hearings. The Office of Attorney General will comply with all applicable federal and state laws, rules, regulations, policies, and guidance governing the Medicaid program.

A copy of the proposed changes will be made available upon request for public review at each county office of the Department of Human Resources and the State Office of the Alabama Medicaid Agency.

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

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for psychiatric facilities for age 65 or over through a State Plan Amendment. This amendment will expand the staffing requirements for psychiatric facilities for individuals 65 or older to include at least one full-time board certified geriatric psychiatrist/geriatrician or one full-time board certified adult psychiatrist with a minimum of 3 years experience caring for geriatric patients 65 or older. Additionally, this amendment requires the facilities to employ only staff who meet training/certification standards in the area of adult psychiatry, as opposed to geriatric psychiatry only, as defined by the State's mental health authority.

A copy of the proposed changes will be made available upon request for public review at each county office of the Department of Human Resources and the State Office of the Alabama Medicaid Agency.
