
SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: (1) 220-2-.02- further regulates arms, ammunition, and methods for hunting; (2) 220-2-.55- further regulates hunting, use of certain campers, and other conduct on those areas; (3) 220-2-.46- further regulates certain fishing and alligator gar limit; (4) 220-2-.147- provides for closed deer season in certain enclosures under certain circumstances; (5) 220-2-.92- further regulates nongame species and adds certain fishes; (6) 220-2-.119- further regulates youth hunting days for deer, turkey and waterfowl; (7) 220-2-.131- further regulates youth turkey hunting.
