INTENDED ACTION: Amend the above rule

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The department proposes to amend the above rule to include the replacement license plate application process, as well as a provision for law enforcement officers to confiscate license plates reported as lost or stolen. In addition, the department proposes to amend the title of the rule.


