
INTENDED ACTION: Amendment

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The new rule is intended to provide administrative procedures as regards the Alabama National Guard Educational Assistance Program administered by the Commission. During the 2014 Session of the Alabama Legislature, Act 2014-179 was passed. This act changed the award amounts available to eligible students. In most instances it is believed that students will be able to have access to more funds on an annual basis. This change affects three areas within the administrative procedures. There is also an amendment to add language that was included in the original 1984 legislation, but not included in the administrative code, related to the maximum number of active duty days that a Guardsman can have before they are no longer eligible to participate in the program.
