AGENCY NAME: Alabama Department of Public Health

RULE NUMBER AND TITLE: 420-7-2, Controlled Substances List, Appendix


INTENDED ACTION: To amend the current Controlled Substances List

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: To amend the current Controlled Substances List to add methylenedioxypropylamphetamine (MDPV) and mephedrone. MDPV is considered by the Drug Enforcement Agency, Office of Diversion Control (DEA) to be a chemical analogue of the controlled substance cathinone. The substance mephedrone is considered by DEA to be a chemical analogue of the controlled substance methcathinone. Cathinone and methcathinone are listed in the DEA and the Alabama Controlled Substances Lists as Schedule I (f), Stimulants.

TIME, PLACE, AND MANNER OF PRESENTING VIEWS: A public hearing will be held on April 18, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the Alabama Department of Public Health, RSA Tower, 201 Monroe Street, Suite 1540, Montgomery, Alabama.
