

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Effective April 1, 2012, the Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend 4.19B pages 5 and 6 and 3.1A page 2.4b of the Alabama State Plan for Medical Assistance.

The purpose of the amendment is to change reimbursement for school-based direct care services from the current Fee-For-Service (FFS) payment methodology to a FFS cost settlement arrangement.

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Effective July 1, 2012, the Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend Attachments 3.1-A pages 6.13a-6.13f and 4.19-B page 11 of the Alabama State Plan for Medical Assistance relating to Rehabilitative Option services.

The primary purpose for this amendment is to add additional services that will be provided to mentally ill and substance abuse recipients. These recipients receive care through the Department of Mental Health, Department of Human Resources and the Department of Youth Services. Additionally, the payment methodology for Rehabilitative Option services will be explained in more detail.

A copy of the proposed changes will be made available upon request for public review at each county office of the Department of Human Resources and the State Office of the Alabama Medicaid Agency.
