<u>Certification Requirements for Individuals Who</u> <u>Supervise Installation, Closure, and Repair of UST</u>

Systems (Amend)

INTENDED ACTION: The Alabama Department of Environmental Management proposes to amend Administrative Code Rule 335-6-15-.47.

SUBSTANCE OR PROPOSED ACTION: A revision is being proposed to this rule to clarify that a certified individual is not required to add or inspect internal linings, or repair fiberglass-reinforced plastic tanks. Also, a revision is being proposed to this rule to allow out-of-state jobs performed after July 16, 2012 to be counted as experience, with proper documentation, by the individual applying for certification. Another proposed revision to this rule would allow owners performing work at their own facilities, and meeting certain compliance conditions, to use the Alabama Underground and Aboveground Storage Tank Trust Fund to meet financial responsibility requirements. Another revision is being proposed to this rule to add excavation work around under dispenser containment to the list of repair critical junctures. Finally, revisions are being proposed to this rule to add and remove references which would allow this rule to agree with revisions proposed in previous rules; to remove reference to the Alabama Board of General Contractors; and to correct typographical errors.
