**CHANGE IN FINAL DATE FOR COMMENT AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AMENDMENT  
TO RULE 460-X-24, FEES CHARGED FOR HISTORIC SITE ADMISSIONS AND SITES OWNED BUT NOT  
OPERATED BY THE ALABAMA HISTORICAL COMMISSION**

The Alabama Historical Commission is changing the final date for comments and giving notice of a public hearing at its board meeting to consider proposed amendments to Chapter 460-x-24 of the Commission's rules, to February 3, 2016.

The Commission will continue to receive comments until February 3, 2016, and will receive oral comments at its meeting on February 3, 2016. The meeting will still be held at the Alabama State Capitol at 600 Dexter Avenue, Montgomery, AL 36130. The purpose of the amendment is to change the fees charged at historic sites for admissions and various services. In addition, the amendment will add the property Belle Mont to the list of properties owned, but not operated by the Alabama Historical Commission.

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. Effective January 1, 2016, this amendment will allow for an update to the supplemental drug rebate contract in order to further facilitate the collection of supplemental rebates in addition to the federal drug rebate provided for in Title XIX.
