INTENDED ACTION:

Amending Rules 660-5-26-.03, 660-5-26-.04, 660-5-26-.06,

660-5-26-.09

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The rules for Minimum Standards for Day Care Centers and Nighttime Centers requiring that Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid certification must be obtained from the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association or the National Safety Council, are being amended due to challenges that the rules are too restrictive and do not allow other agencies to provide certification. The rules are being amended to eliminate the list of certification agencies. The rules are also being amended to prohibit on-line CPR and First Aid training and to clarify that hours required to obtain CPR and First Aid certification are not counted toward the provider's required pre-licensing or annual training in child care. The word "pediatric" is being added as a clarification, since it is often used on CPR training certificates rather than the words "infant-child".
