SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: The Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) provides guidelines for placing Indian children in foster care or adoptive homes that reflect the values of their Indian culture. The guidelines established by federal statute are to protect the integrity of Indian tribes and assure that state child welfare practices acknowledge the vital role that the child's cultural heritage and tribal community must play in child welfare decision-making for Indian children.
