RULE NUMBER AND TITLE: 420-2-2-.07 Patient Entry Criteria for Hospitals

INTENDED ACTION: To establish criteria for in-hospital personnel to enter into the Alabama Trauma System a patient who has been involved in a trauma or burn incident.

SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION: While most patients will be entered into the trauma system by the EMTs who care for them in the field, some patients bypass the prehospital EMS system and are delivered to hospitals by private vehicles. It is in the best interest of these patients to be entered into the trauma system in order to facilitate their transfer to the appropriate trauma hospital, if the original hospital lacks the resources to care for them. Also, by being entered into the trauma system, information about the patients and their care is captured by the trauma registry for the quality improvement process. The Patient Entry Criteria for Hospitals will accomplish this.
