

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### SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. This amendment will allow the Alabama Medicaid Agency to apply the reimbursement methodology for inpatient and outpatient hospitals services for State fiscal years 2015 through 2016 with the following changes:

- Revise methodology to determine Upper Payment Limits and remove limits on certain hospital services; and
- Revise methodology to determine uncompensated care cost used for hospital disproportionate share payments and related state funding
