SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Effective October 1, 2015, the Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend Attachment 4.19 B of the Alabama State Plan for Medical Assistance. The plan is being amended in order to allow eligible primary care physicians with a specialty of family medicine, general internal medicine or pediatric medicine to receive enhanced payments for certain primary care services and Vaccines for Children (VFC) vaccine administration codes.


