

SUBJECT: <u>AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL</u> ASSISTANCE

Effective October 1, 2016, the Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend Attachment 4.19 B of the Alabama State Plan for Medical Assistance. The plan is being amended in order to resume enhanced payments through the Alabama Medicaid Physicians Primary Care Enhanced Rates "Bump" Program. The amendment will impact physicians with a primary specialty designation of family medicine, pediatric medicine or internal medicine under the requirements of 42 C.F.R. § 447.400.

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE ALABAMA STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

The Alabama Medicaid Agency is proposing to amend its State Plan for Medical Assistance through a State Plan Amendment. This amendment will extend the State Plan Amendment for Hospital Services and Reimbursement for one year using the same cost reimbursement methodology as the last three years. The effective dates of this State Plan Amendment will be October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.
