SUBSTANCE OF PROPOSED ACTION:

In adopting the Darren "Ato" Wesley Hall Compassion Act; codified at Ala. Code, 1975, § 20-2A-1, et seq., the Alabama legislature found that the establishment of a program for the administration of cannabis use would benefit qualified individuals by providing relief for pain and other debilitating conditions, while also improving the quality of life.

In furtherance of such findings and goals the State has charged the Commission with the swift licensing of qualified cannabis cultivators, processors, dispensaries, transporters and integrated providers.

The Commission's licensing process has been the subject of litigation relating to the application submission process, the scoring of applications, and procedures for the approval and stay of license awards.

Prior license awards have been the subject of a Temporary Restraining Order and has been administratively stayed by the Commission pending further review.

At the request of the Montgomery County Circuit Court, the Commission's representatives have participated in discussions addressing some of the legal issues before the Court in an effort to permit the licensing process to continue.

The Commission has determined that certain new and amended regulations are needed to address some of the issues raised in the Circuit Court litigation and provide a path forward for licenses to be awarded and issued, and for medical cannabis to thus be made available to qualifying Alabama citizens.

The Commission has received numerous communications from the public supporting the need for the swift licensing of providers to allow medical cannabis to be administered to qualified individuals.

Based on the forgoing, the Commission finds that the uncertainties and delays surrounding the licensing process present an immediate danger to public health and welfare requiring adoption of certain rules, on an emergency basis, upon fewer than 35 days' notice as permitted by Ala. Code § 41-22-5 (b).

This proposed action is for the normal publication and comment process to proceed for revisions to current rules that complement the adopted emergency rule.

This proposed rule revisions are designed to protect the "public health and welfare" by carrying out the legislative mandate of licensing medical cannabis providers to allow prescribing physicians to provide relief to qualified patients, and is intended to reduce the regulatory burden facing those involved in the current process by providing a clear path toward resolution, thus falling under the exceptions to the Governor's Executive Order.

In adopting the Darren "Ato" Wesley Hall Compassion Act; codified at Ala. Code, 1975, § 20-2A-1, et seq., the Alabama legislature found that the establishment of a program for the administration of cannabis use would benefit qualified individuals by providing relief for pain and other debilitating conditions, while also improving the quality of life.

In furtherance of such findings and goals the State has charged the Commission with the swift licensing of qualified cannabis cultivators, processors, dispensaries, transporters and integrated providers.

The Commission's licensing process has been the subject of litigation relating to the application submission process, the scoring of applications, and procedures for the approval and stay of license awards.

Prior license awards have been the subject of a Temporary Restraining Order and has been administratively stayed by the Commission pending further review.

At the request of the Montgomery County Circuit Court, the Commission's representatives have participated in discussions addressing some of the legal issues before the Court in an effort to permit the licensing process to continue.

The Commission has determined that certain new and amended regulations are needed to address some of the issues raised in the Circuit Court litigation and provide a path forward for licenses to be awarded and issued, and for medical cannabis to thus be made available to qualifying Alabama citizens.

The Commission has received numerous communications from the public supporting the need for the swift licensing of providers to allow medical cannabis to be administered to qualified individuals.

Based on the forgoing, the Commission finds that the uncertainties and delays surrounding the licensing process present an immediate danger to public health and welfare requiring adoption of certain rules, on an emergency basis, upon fewer than 35 days' notice as permitted by Ala. Code § 41-22-5 (b). This proposed action is for the normal publication and comment process to proceed for adoption of permanent rules that complement the adopted emergency rule.

This proposed rule is designed to protect the "public health and welfare" by carrying out the legislative mandate of licensing medical cannabis providers to allow prescribing physicians to provide relief to qualified patients, and is intended to reduce the regulatory burden facing those involved in the current process by providing a clear path toward resolution, thus falling under the exceptions to the Governor's Executive Order.
